

PROJECT STORY



Coomera Cutters has recently had their new club house built however the fit out is yet to be completed and we need your help to finish off our new rooms. Cost spent on building the clubhouse are at \$300,000 of which the majority of funds have come from Government Grants & Council funding. Whilst the club has been successful in receiving funding from a number of government and community organisations an additional \$20,000 needs to be raised to finish the new rooms.

To renovate the inside of the newly established club house and ensure it its operating efficiently.

WHAT MAKES THIS PROJECT SPECIAL

The club is a pivotal part in the community and it is essential we offer our members and guests the best training facilities and ground in order to grow successfully. Sporting clubs are the foundation of the community promoting social inclusion and physical activity. A study by the The Centre for Sport and Social Impact (CSSI) at La Trobe University has found that for every \$1 spent on local football clubs, at least \$4.40 is returned in social value, improving employment outcomes, mental well being and personal development highlighting the need to ensure growth for the Coomera Cutters.
